- Proposals are written in English and are 150-200 words, including a title.
- Please indicate in the proposal what type of primary source material you have been working with.
- In addition to the proposal, please include a bio of no more than 30 words.
- Submit your proposal and your bio in a single pdf document **no later than 21 May 2024** to slaveryconference@hetscheepvaartmuseum.nl.
- If your poster proposal is accepted, you are expected to bring an A2 poster (42 x 59 cm) to the conference.
- Students, those who have recently completed their studies, and PhD candidates, are especially encouraged to submit a proposal.
- Decisions will be communicated no later than 31 May 2024.
